Private equity

Startup

A young and innovative company that typically strives for rapid international growth with a scalable business model.

Growth company

A company with established operations, revenue & potential for continued growth. Revenue can range from a few million to hundreds of millions.

Venture capital

Venture capital investorsmake **minority** investments in startups in different growth stages.

Growth

Growth investors make minority investments in both later-stage startups and establised but still small growth companies.

Buyout

Buyout investors make **majority** investments in established businesses, typically mid-sized growth companies.






Buyout & growth H1/2025 Statistics in brief

- Finnish buyout and growth investors raised €526m (+212 % YoY)
 new funds for future investments.
- Finnish buyout and growth investors invested €148m (-1%) in
 29 (-3%) companies.
- **85** % of the investments by Finnish buyout and growth investors were made in Finnish companies.
- Finnish buyout and growth investors made exits from **11** (+22 %) portfolio companies.
- **30** (-23 %) Finnish growth companies received a total of **€161m** (-55 %) in investments from Finnish and foreign investors.
- Of this amount, €35m (-83 %) came from foreign investors and was invested in 5 (-58 %) Finnish companies.









Fundraising of Finnish buyout and growth investors






Strong fundraising continued

€526m

Finnish buyout and growth investors raised the third-largest amount of the review period during the first half of 2025.

In January-June 2025, DevCo's €521 million continuation fund had a significant impact on the overall fundraising volume.


Fundraising of Finnish buyout and growth investors





Investments by Finnish buyout and growth investors were significantly below the reviewperiod average of €246 million.

Investments by Finnish buyout and growth investors






Deal count below the levels of recent years

The number of companies receiving buyout or growth investments was below the recent historical average of 36 companies.


The number of deals also includes small follow-on investments in euro terms, which is clearly reflected in the lower total investment amount.

Divestments


Gradual improvement in exits

Exits by Finnish buyout and growth investors have increased over the past two half-year periods from the lows seen in 2023.


The number of exits has returned close to the long-term average of 12 companies.

Divestments by Finnish buyout and growth investors











161 million euros for Finnish growth companies between January and June in 2025






Investment amount at a significantly low level

Buyout and growth investments received by Finnish growth companies were at the lowest level of the entire review period during the first half of 2025.

Several large investments have been announced in H2 2025, and these are expected to significantly increase the full-year total.

Buyout and growth investments in Finnish companies






Number of investment targets at its lowest level

Foreign investments in Finnish companies at an exceptionally low level








B2B companies are the most popular targets for buyout and growth investments


B2B companies receive the largest share of buyout and growth investments in terms of number of companies.

Buyout and growth investments into Finnish companies by industry 2020–24 & H1/2025










Divestments

11 companies


Foreign and domestic private equity investors' exits from Finnish growth companies have recovered from the lows of 2023 but remain below the reviewperiod average of 13 companies.






Fundraising of Finnish venture capital and private equity investors

Fundraising of Finnish venture capital and private equity funds










Venture capital and private equity investments in Finnish companies

Venture capital and private equity investments in Finnish companies







Venture capital, growth and buyout statistics in brief

- Finnish venture capital and private equity investors invested a total of €374m in 185 domestic and foreign growth companies.
- 129 Finnish startup and growth companies received 412 M€ in investments from Finnish and foreign investors.
- New funds raised by Finnish venture capital funds, totalling
 €632m in H1/2025, will be invested in startup and growth companies in the coming years.







Methodology

The following private equity associations are cooperating with EDC

The statistics describing the Finnish private equity industry are based on information received from European Data Cooperative (EDC) private equity database.

- A fully functional, centralised non-commercial pan-European private equity database.
- With its own staff, internal resources and web portal.
- Information is collected directly from VC/PE investors via an online survey and complemented with public sources of information.
- Figures are updated continuously and are therefore subject to change.

Note: The EDC statistics include only VC/PE firms' (including evergreens and captives) investments. Syndicate and direct investments made by several other investors, e.g. LP co-investors, individuals, entrepreneurs, business angels, management, corporates, funds-of-funds, other asset managers and financial institutions, are not included in EDC statistics. The activity falling outside EDC's methodology is however included in the figures in the section "Investments in Finnish startups".



Methodology

Investment and divestment statistics are aggregated via two methods – industry statistics and market statistics

Industry statistics

- By country of private equity firm's office
- Here: Domestic and foreign investments/divestments made by the Finnish offices of private equity firms

Market statistics

- By the location of the portfolio company
- Here: Investments/divestments in/from Finnish portfolio companies made by domestic and foreign private equity firms

Note: The aggregated figures may not always sum up to totals due to rounding. Some graphs may exclude unspecified variables.

Fundraising is classified based on the location of the advisory team. Investments are classified according to the location of the office responsible for the investment.
